SWIMMING SECTION

Section Event Friday 22nd - 24th May, 2015

The swimming squad participated in the 44th International Swimming Competition held in Arnsberg, Germany from 22nd to 24th May, 2015.

50 different clubs from 10 countries participated in this year's competition and our swimming squad came in 6th position. The Ikoyi Club swimming squad were the best among the African representatives at the championship.



SWIMMING HONOURS IN GERMANY

The Squad squared up against the other Clubs from nine countries. Of the 24 swimmers who represented Ikoyi Club 1938, 13 came back with Medals.

Leading the medallist was Maria Perner, who won 8 gold and 4 silver medals. Her gold haul came from 50, 100, 200, 400, Freestyle, 50 and 100 Butterfly, 50 Backstroke and 200 Breaststroke. She won the silver in 50 Breaststroke, 100 and 200 Backstroke and 200I.M.

Obehi Emafo followed with 4 gold medals in 50 and 200 Freestyle, 50 and 100 Breaststroke, 3 silver medals in 100 Freestyle, 50 and 100 Butterfly.

Iman Adama won 3 gold and 2 silver medals. Other medallists were: Osajie Imevbore – 2 gold and 2 silvers medals. Luka Okoji – 2 gold and 2 bronze medals. Seun Alaofin – 1 gold, 1 silver medals,

Adewale Adekoya – 1 gold, 2 silver, 1 bronze medals, Morayo Okungbowa – 1 gold, 2 bronze medals, Chiamaka Kanu – 1 gold, 2 bronze medals, Oise Imevbore -1 gold medal, Arolape Benson – 1 silver, 1 bronze medals, Akaolisa Nweze – 1 silver medal and Dare Alabi – 1 bronze.

Many were also honoured with 4th, 5th and 6th place recognitions. Although Adeola Adekoya, Ohi Imevbore, Khadijah Azeez, Sophia Ekundayo, Nina Oduwusi, Tosan Obatoyinbo, Adebayo Nylander, Nulia Nwokolo and Nodebenna Nwokolo did not win any prize, the experience left a deep impression on them.

The squad, their handlers and indeed the Club are grateful to the four banks that sponsored the trip: Ecobank, Heritage, Diamond and G.TBank.

Improving Your **MEMBERSHIP EXPERIENCE** in the Club

The need to improve the services of our Membership Services Office was a front-burner on the campaign trail during the last election as virtually all Members the undersigned spoke to had one or two things to say on this.

On assumption of office as the Honorary Secretary of the Club, the undersigned carried out an appraisal of the tools that are presently on ground. I was pleasantly surprised to discover that the Club has an ERP Software which has an integrated Customer Relationship Management Module, which is yet to be activated.

The above Module if and when activated and implemented will enable the Office to operate as a full Customer Experience Centre with facilities to drive better customer relationship services to Members.

We have immediately included in the budget for the on-coming period provisions for implementation of the following projects which we believe will serve to improve services and the experience of Members whilst using the Club:

- i. Provision of a Club wide Wireless Network which will provide wi-fi services to members in any part of the Club.
- ii. Procurement and Installation of computer based Point of Sales payment terminals linked to the stores in all club owned bars and sale outlets. This will enable the Club have full control and supervision of its inventory and block

all the identified leakages in the present system. This will also serve as the platform for the implementation of a cash-less payment environment within the Club which has been on the drawing board for so long.

iii. Upgrade and conversion of the Membership Services Office into an ultra-modern Customer Experience Centre with full complement of telephone and communication equipment. This is expected to be sponsored by one of the club's bankers even though provision has been made in the budget.

iv. Procurement of a Document Management Software to enable the Club digitise and properly keep and manage membership data of members.

We intend to commence training of the staff of the Membership Services Office shortly on Customer Service skills so as to improve their performance and it isn't unlikely that one or two experienced hands in the Customer Service Industry will be employed to further strengthen the performance of that function in the Club for your benefit.

The children have not been left out as arrangements have been concluded with GT Bank to upgrade and completely overhaul the Children's playground.

All these initiatives will be put in place within the next few months as Members certainly deserve the best and your General Committee shall endeavour to ensure this.
