Good day and I hope this message meets you well. The General Committee (GC) met and discussed, among other matters, the state of our readiness to reopen the Club in line with the recent announcement made by the State Government and the requirements to meet the protocols outlined by the Presidential Task

You will recall that the Lagos State Safety Commission (LSSC) had in June 2020 visited the Club and issued the Provisional Safety Compliance Clearance to enable us commence recreational activities.

Considering all relevant circumstances and in order to ensure a smooth and safe access to our esteemed members on reopening, the GC came to the decision that the Club be reopened with effect from 7am on Monday, August 17, 2020.

Details on the protocols to be observed while on the Club premises will be announced shortly.

THE LSSC GUIDELINES



ear Esteemed Members,

In line with the Lagos State Governor's recent directive that social clubs can reopen from the 14th of August, 2020, the General Committee (with the guidance of the medical subcommittee and the LSSC) has decided on the following measures to guide our reopening activities during this Covid-19 pandemic.

The reopening process will be gradual and broken into phases.

PHASE 1 4 weeks

All sections will be open with structures to ensure the health and safety of people within the premises are in place. Only members who have booked will be granted access to the facility for a fixed duration, as specified by the sections. Bars, kitchens and restaurants remain shut. No visitors and quests will be allowed into the Club.

PHASE 2

4 weeks

All sections will be open with structures to ensure the health and safety of people within the premises are in place. Only members who have booked will be granted access to the facility for a fixed duration, as specified by the sections. Bars, kitchens and restaurants remain shut. No visitors and quests will be allowed into the Club.

PHASE 3

Full reopening of the Club with structures to ensure the health and safety of people within the premises are in place

During all phases, the following guidelines will be prevalent:

- 1. Full compliance with the NCDC and Lagos state safety commission's protocol.
- For all members and guests, the advice remains that anyone who feels unwell should stay at home. The Club does not have the capacity during this period to manage any form of illness and would not be held liable for any illness to a member.
- 3. Anyone with temperatures of 37.5 deg C and above will be turned back at the entrance.
- 4. There would be a daily log of all individuals including members who come into the club at the entrances. Members are enjoined to use their individual pens/biros to fill in their membership number, contact number, next of kin, time in, time out and sign off on the register daily.
- 5. All vulnerable individuals (over 65yrs of age or anyone with underlying health conditions, including but not limited to, high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, obesity, asthma or other autoimmune disorders, and those whose immune system is compromised by chemotherapy or immunotherapy) are advised to continue to shelter in place.
- Persons who live with a vulnerable individual should be equally cautious in coming to the club and take necessary precautions to prevent introducing an illness into the home inadvertently.
- All access control devices are turned off. Members will
 only show both their membership and financial cards
 to the security staff in order to access the club. Any
 member without both cards will be denied access to
 the club.
- Entrance doors would be left ajar during club operating hours.
- 9. Limited/regulated number of people within the club and sections taking into consideration social/physical













distancing as stipulated by the state guidelines/in line with Lagos state safety commission's protocol.

- Members should make frequent (immediately after contact with any person or surface) use of the hand washing stations and sanitizers distributed across the club at strategic places.
- Every person in the facility must wear a facemask at all times (except for players on and while working out).
- Regular sanitization of surfaces, sporting areas and routine decontamination of sections after each use will be carried out by staff.
- 13. All enclosed bars (Main bar, Golf bar, Guinness bar, Heineken bar, Snooker bar, Squash bar, Swimming bar, Tennis bar, Table Tennis bar, Badminton bar and Aerobics & Other Sports bar) will remain closed during phase one of the reopening.
- 14. Only water will be sold at the sections' bars.
- 15. Members are advised to use the terraces.
- Booking of games can be done online, by phone or in person.
- 17. All sporting activities to stop at 7pm daily.
- 18. Only skeletal services will be provided with staff on the last shift closing at 7pm daily.
- 19. All tournaments and social events in the Club remain suspended.
- 20. All Kitchens in the Club (private vendors inclusive) remain

closed.

- 21. Pharmacy and clinic will open. All other shops remain closed
- 22. For ATMs, there will be serviette boxes at each point for members to use the serviettes in punching the buttons at no risk to themselves and others.
- 23. For POS, members will be encouraged to use sanitizers to be carried by each staff member as well as serviettes.
- 24. The quick teller online pay
 - ment is also functional for members use. Soon, the use of QR codes for payments will be introduced.
- 25. Caddies services at the Golf section and ball boys at the Tennis section remain suspended.

- The library activities are suspended in phase one of the reopening.
- 27. No guests will be allowed into the Club.
- 28. Members will always be updated and notified of any actions taken
